- 1. Lewis County Fire Board Request for Levy Order:** The Lewis County Fire Board requests the Lewis County Commission enter an order allowing the organization to hold a special election on January 6, 2018 for the purpose of posing to the voters an excess levy to benefit the volunteer fire departments in Lewis County. This levy will be for a duration of five years and generate \$598,975.00 annually to be split between six departments. If approved the special election will be held Saturday, January 6, 2018. (*action required*)

LEWIS COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING MANAGEMENT

- Regular meeting agendas will be posted and available to the public before closure two (2) business days prior to the meeting date.
- Agenda matters to be reviewed and/or considered during the meeting are at the discretion of the Lewis County Commission.
- Appointments to speak with the county commission must be scheduled before 10 AM three (3) business days prior to the meeting. Appointments will be given a ten (10) minute time allowance.
- Open discussion by Commission unless executive session is motioned per WV Code §6-9A-4.
- Input or recommendation from constitutional officers, staff or public that is not listed by name on the agenda will only be allowed if requested by the commission or required by statute.
- Those not scheduled on the agenda may sign up for public comment at a minimum fifteen (15) minutes prior to the start of the meeting. Public comment is limited to five (5) minutes per speaker.
- Motion required for consideration of vote.
- All votes unanimous unless otherwise stated.
