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

*Whereas*, in our country, more than three women are murdered by their husbands or boyfriends every day;


*Whereas*, children who grow up in violent homes are believed to be abused and neglected at a rate higher than the national average;




*Whereas*, only a coordinated community effort will put a stop to this heinous crime;

The Walkersville Fire Department will host a Town Hall Meeting on October 11, 2012, with an invitation extended to the Lewis County Commissioners. Steve Mealey stopped by Commission with the new rescue truck at Walkersville for Commissioners to see.

Received Press Release regarding FEMA Registration for individuals with damages caused by the June 29, 2012 DERECHO. Although Lewis County is not a FEMA designated county for individuals who suffered damages/losses caused by the June 29, 2012 DERECHO, the WV Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management is requesting all individuals with damages to report their losses to FEMA by calling 1-800-621-FEMA. By reporting losses to FEMA we may be able to demonstrate the need to have Lewis County added to the declaration for individual assistance.

Received information from Vivian Parsons that the expected PERS employer contribution rate for July 1, 2013 will be 14.5% according to Ms Miller at the Consolidated Public Retirement Board.

The Finance Board of the Public Employees Insurance Agency will hold a service of public hearings in November to gain input on the proposed changes for FY 2014. While the proposal does not include a premium increase for participants, there are proposed cost increased that will impact employees. The nearest meeting will be held Tuesday, November 13 at the Ramada Inn, Morgantown, WV.




