The Lewis County Commission convened an Emergency Meeting November 2, 2012 at 5:00PM at the Lewis County Courthouse with a quorum of the membership present. The purpose of this meeting is to address voting precinct issues resulting from the Natural Disaster caused by Hurricane Sandy.

October 31, 2012 at 9:00 AM the Lewis County Commission signed a Proclamation declaring a State of Emergency in Lewis County. This declaration is still active.

Lewis County, Precinct #3, located at Roanoke School in Courthouse Collins Settlement Magisterial District is without power. This facility does not have generator capabilities. The Lewis County Commission believes that power will not be restored in time for the November 6, 2012 General Election.

Per WV Code 3-1-7 (f) and 3-1-7(g), the Lewis County Commission orders the emergency relocation of Precinct #3, Roanoke School, Courthouse Collins Settlement Magisterial District to Lewis County High School also located in Courthouse Collins Settlement Magisterial District for the November 6, 2012 General Election. This emergency relocation has been approved by the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office. Polling hours will be 6:30 AM until 7:30 AM. Upon motion of Thomas V. Fealy, seconded by Agnes G. Queen, motion passing.

With no further action being required of the Lewis County Commission, the Emergency Meeting was adjourned at 3:15 PM Upon motion of Thomas V. Fealy, seconded by Agnes G. Queen, motion passing.
