



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IN RE: UPDATE ON ROAD SIGNS AND GIS PROJECT

David Matthews, 911 Addressing Coordinator informed the Commission that all private road signs are up. He also noted that a meeting needed to be arranged with Landmark to have new roads added to GIS project.

IN RE: MINI GRANT SUMMERS KNIGHTS

After a discussion as to what year the grant was for, upon motion of Agnes G. Queen, second by Thomas V. Fealy, vote unanimous, to table until more information is received.

IN RE: WV COURTHOUSE FACILITIES IMPROVEMENT GRANT 21-0110-012013

Upon motion of Agnes G. Queen, second by Thomas V. Fealy, vote unanimous to sign the acceptance contract for the grant award from the WV Courthouse Facilities Improvement Authority in the amount of \$38,629.00 to be used to repair/replace the roof, gutter, downspouts and fascia on the former jail and jailers quarters of the Lewis County Courthouse. Recorded in Miscellaneous Book 15 Page 399.

IN RE: MODIFICATION TO PERSONNEL POLICY

Upon motion of Agnes G. Queen, second by Thomas V. Fealy, vote unanimous, to amend the Lewis County Personnel Policy regarding reference information requests for current and/or former employees. The policy is to be amended to read: "It is the policy and procedure of the Lewis County Commission to only confirm dates of employment."

IN RE: ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER REQUESTS

1. Fender Flares: Commission decided this was not a necessary expenditure at this time.
2. Request from John Snyder, Animal Control Officer to convert 100 hours of compensatory time to sick leave: Upon motion of Agnes G. Queen, second by Thomas V. Fealy, vote unanimous to allow Mr. Snyder to convert 100 hours of compensatory time to sick leave.
3. Consideration of approval of draft to animal control officer policy regarding response to call: Tabled for further review.

IN RE: GARY MORRIS PROSECUTING ATTORNEY, VARIOUS ITEMS

1. Request for budget revision: Gary Morris, Prosecuting Attorney withdrew request for budget revision approval by commission. Mr. Morris was transferring money within his 405 budget and Commission approval was not necessary.
2. List of Transfer Title for Assessors (West Virginia Code 11-4-8): Mr. Morris was asked by Assessor T. Chad Kelley to research above referenced code. It was the opinion of the Prosecuting

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Attorney that County Clerk Mary Lou Myers should furnish to the Assessor's office by the 10th of the following month all transfers of property in format prescribed by code. County Clerk Mary Lou Myers informed the Commission that she was unaware that sending a copy of the sales listing form, and deed or will, was not in compliance with State Code. She requested an additional employee to help, as her girls were covered up with work and would not have the time to perform the additional duties. She requested the hiring of additional personnel be put on the agenda for the next meeting. She also informed commission that until a person could be hired that her part time worker, Harriett Attanasio would be working additional hours. Upon motion of Agnes G. Queen, second by Thomas V. Fealy, vote unanimous to direct the County Clerk, Mary Lou Myers to follow the code on transfer of title.

3. Follow up on information from Lewis County Commission Meeting of December 10, 2012: No items were discussed.

IN RE: JOHN CARROLL – VARIOUS ITEMS

1. Report of activities by the Ambulance Authority: John Carroll, EMS Director reported that they had purchased a new ambulance in 2009 and with the help of the Lewis County Commission had paid off the loan in 18 months. They are planning to replace a 1998 ambulance this coming year with the help of the commission if possible. Trade in for the used ambulance is between \$5,000.00 and \$7,000.00. Cost for a new ambulance is \$125,000.00. They had also updated their radio system, also with the help of the commission.
2. Two Emergency Medical Technicians, James Taylor and Kenneth Roy have completed training for EMTI. This allows them to perform advanced life support.
3. John Carroll informed the commission of his intension to retire. Chris McCall will take the vacated position on January 1, 2013. John Carroll will work full time until the end of February, 2013. Mr. Carroll is planning to work part time to help Mr. McCall transition into the new position.

IN RE: MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN LEWIS COUNTY, TOWN OF JANE LEW AND LEWIS COUNTY OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

William Rowan, Director, OEMS presented to the Commission for approval a Memorandum of Understanding between the Lewis County Commission, the Town of Jane Lew and the Lewis County Office of Emergency Management. Upon motion of Agnes G. Queen, second by Thomas V. Fealy, vote unanimous, to sign the Memorandum of Understanding. The purpose of this memorandum of understanding is to clearly identify the roles and responsibilities of each party as they relate to the overall emergency preparedness of the Town of Jane Lew for the purpose of facilitating communication among the several law enforcement agencies, fire and hazmat agencies, Office of Emergency Management, and Town Officials in times of emergency. Said MOU is recorded in the Lewis County Clerk's office in the Miscellaneous Book 15 Page 395.

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IN RE: WILLIAM ROWAN – AFTER ACTION MEETING

The commission questions Mr. Rowan on results of the “After Action Meeting”. Mr. Rowan said some things needed adjusted and many lessons were learned. If schools cannot be used for sheltering, at this time there were not enough alternative shelters. We need more shelters approved through the Lewis County Health Department. We need more cots. Charlie Straley questions whether the commission’s liability insurance was sufficient. Mr. Rowan had also met with the County Fire Association and asked them to get their 501(c)3. If they had this designation and individual fire departments did not meet the minimum expenditure in a disaster, they could combine several fire departments under the County Fire Association and meet minimum threshold on financial assistance.

IN RE: OATH OF OFFICE LAW ENFORCEMENT DEPUTIES AND PROCESS SERVER

Chad Moneypenny, Sergeant Judd Holcomb, Sergeant Michael Posey, Sergeant James E. Browning, Sergeant Michael Cayton, Deputy Robert Ryan, and Process Server Randall Bush.

IN RE: REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT MARKETING GRANT
FOR LEWIS, UPSHUR AND RANDOLPH COUNTIES

The Lewis County Economic Development Authority has agreed to participate in a 50/50 matching marketing grant with Upshur and Randolph Counties. The purpose of this marketing initiative will be to develop a regional “branding concept” for the purpose of promoting the three county area by developing a media strategy and producing print and video tools to present the positives aspects of this region. The Lewis County Economic Development Authority will contribute \$3,333.33 for the 1/3 share of the 50% local grant match. On motion of Agnes G. Queen, second by Thomas V. Fealy, vote unanimous, to support the Lewis County Economic Development Authority’s participation in this grant, as well as, the regional marketing concept.

IN RE: PURCHASING CARD FOR BARBARA WINANS


