1. **Upshur County Commission Agenda** – A copy of the Upshur County Commission for January 3, 2013 was filed. Community Corrections meeting was noted. Thomas V. Fealy commented that all commissioners were invited to attend the meeting.
2. **Notification from West Virginia State Tax Department:** The West Virginia Tax Department will be contracting with Tyler Technologies to update the Integrated Assessment System for Property Taxes; the current system over is 12 years old. This upgrade will provide the assessor's office with the needed capability for improved property tax administration. The West Virginia State Tax Department will pay some of the initial start-up fees, the cost to Lewis County will be \$7,215.00 billed quarterly. This will be paid out of the General County Fund budget line item 001-408-349.0.
3. **Lewis County Assessor's Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Property Valuation Budget** – Copy of the Lewis County Assessor's Valuation FY 2013-14 received for review.
4. **Weston Rotary Mini Grant Completion Report** – The mini grant completion report for the Santa's House and Christmas Parade was received.
5. **Lewis County Honor Guard Mini Grant Completion Report** – The mini grant completion report for fuel was received.
6. **Review of Clean Air Regulation Act of 2012 by Gary Morris, Immediate Past Lewis County Prosecuting Attorney** – In the opinion of Gary Morris, Prosecuting Attorney, dated December 31, 2012, "It would then be my recommendation that, both in their individual best interests, and in the interests of all of the citizens they represent, the Board, in considering this issue, consider the hasty manner in which these regulations were propounded, the circumvention of jurisprudential input and review in the adoption process, the lack of procedural due process concerns expressed by those advocating a hasty adoption of the same and that **each and every member of the board seek, and obtain, independent legal counsel** to advise them of the pitfalls associated with the hasty adoption of a regulation which has far reaching potential consequences for both those regulating and those regulated." A complete copy of the opinion is available in the County Clerk's office. Lucinda Whetsell informed the commission that this item is on the Lewis County Board of Health's Agenda for the January 8, 2013 meeting. Commissioners declined to attend the meeting as they had no authority in the proceedings.
7. **Notification from the West Virginia Development Office:** Notification that the 2012 West Virginia Small Cities block Grant Application for the Northwest Lewis County Water Project was not funded.
