REGULAR
SESSION: MONDAY, MARCH 18, 2013**

Commission sat pursuant to adjournment of Monday, March 4, 2013.
PRESENT: Honorable Patrick D. Boyle, President, Thomas V. Fealy and Agnes G. Queen, Commissioners
The foregoing proceedings of this Commission were approved and signed by the President.

IN RE: MINUTES, INVITATIONS, NOTIFICATIONS, CORRESPONDENCE

1. **Upshur County Commission Agenda** – A copy of the Upshur County Commission Agenda for March 7, 2013 was filed with notation of meeting dates this month.
2. **Sheriff's Vehicle Report**– Report for Sheriff's Cruisers Repair and Mileage for February, 2013 with notation of only 3 vehicles over 100,000 miles was filed.
3. **Sheriff's Monthly Settlement for February, 2013**–A copy of the Sheriff's Monthly Settlement for February was filed.
4. **West Virginia Regional Jail and Correctional Facility Authority Invoice** – A copy of the monthly invoice was filed with notation that it was less than prior month and that next month could be more as there were several indictments.
5. **Lewis/Upshur Emergency Planning Commission**–Copies of the agenda, minutes, and financial reports for January 16, 2013 and February 20, 2013 was filed. Lucinda Whetsell, County Administrator reported that the Blue Stone Dam incident had been cancelled, but that Region 4 still had an incident scheduled.
6. **Lewis Gilmer E-911 Advisory Board Report**– A copy of the advisory board meeting minutes for February was filed
7. **Lewis County 911 Addressing Report**–A copy of the addressing report for February was filed. Information includes road name packages, citizen contact, proof of address requests, etc. Lucinda Whetsell, County Administrator reported that Landmark Forestry was running master lists for comparison to detect inaccuracies in the addresses.
8. **Gilmer County 911 Addressing Report** –A copy of the addressing report for February was filed. Information includes road name packages, citizen contact, proof of address requests, etc.
9. **Lewis County Certificate of Values-2013 Taxation Year**–The Certificate of Values for the 2013 taxation year was submitted March 1, 2013 to the Lewis County Commission by Lewis County Assessor T. Chad Kelley. The certificate is used for budget purposes.
10. **Louis Bennett Public Library Board Minutes and Financial Statements** –Minutes of the October 12, 2012 and January 28, 2013 for the Louis Bennett Public Library Board including financial reports for October, November, and December, 2012 was filed.
11. **Louis Bennett Public Library Audit Report Ending June 30, 2012** –Audit Report for Fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 for the Louis Bennett Public Library was filed. There were no significant findings other than segregation of duties and petty cash receipt implementation.

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12. **Animal Control Report for February 2013** –Animal Control Report for February, 2013 includes number of complaints, animals picked up and dropped at the Upshur Lewis Animal Pound, money collected and animals adopted. It was noted that a coon was picked up.
13. **West Virginia State Auditor’s Office Property Tax Levy Rates for 2013-2014** – The West Virginia State Auditor’s office has calculated the property tax rates for Lewis County per West Virginia Code 11-8-6e. These calculations are used to identify the rates the county can impose without a public hearing.
14. **Annex Update**-Lucinda Whetsell, County Administrator reported that the contractor is on schedule and that the completion date is still the end of May. Commission directed Ms. Whetsell to work on an RFP for advertisement for a cleaning service for the new annex.
15. **EDA Update** – Commissioner Queen reported that the Bloody Run water project had bid opening scheduled for April 23. The board is reviewing candidates for the director position. Commissioner Queen attended a public service hearing on the WV American Water suit. The Public Service Commission wants to know if a workable solution can be reached and the water company has two weeks to reach a settlement. Commissioner Queen reported the water company want to charge a surcharge if the number of customers decrease from the time of sign up for a project to completion of a project and they want to be able to raise their rates automatically if the Public Service Commission grants the power company an increase.

**IN RE: LEWIS UPSHUR BRAXTON COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS
 REQUEST FOR GRANT MATCH**

Micah Harris, Director for Community Corrections Center appeared before the Commission to request grant match of \$54,163.00 with \$19,642.75 being the cash portion and the rest being 75% of Home Confinement Secretary salary. Ms. Harris reported that the Community Correction Center had saved Lewis County \$306,178.25 in regional jail costs. The grant request to the state was increased \$100,000.00 for the 13/14 Fiscal Year. This includes upgrade of the Lewis County aide to full time and upgrade of the councilor to full time. Upon motion of Thomas V. Fealy, second by Agnes G. Queen, vote unanimous to approve the grant match for the Community Correction Center for the 13/14 Fiscal Year. Ms. Harris also presented to the commission the Cooperative Agreement between the Upshur County Commission and the Lewis County Commission for signature. Upon motion of Thomas V. Fealy, second by Agnes G. Queen, vote unanimous to authorize County Commission President, Patrick D. Boyle to sign the Cooperative Agreement. The agreement is a requirement of the grant. Agreement is recorded in Miscellaneous Book 15 Page 491.

IN RE: OATH OF OFFICE FOR GARNET ROSE ROBINSON

Garnet Rose Robinson being appointed to the position of Louis Bennett Public Library Board on February 18, 2013, appeared before the commission to take her oath of office. Oath of office was given by President Patrick D. Boyle. Oath of Office is recorded in Oath of Office Book 2 Page 113.

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IN RE: TRI-COUNTY VISITATION CENTER REQUEST FOR ANNUAL FUNDING

Joyce Harris Thacker, Director, Upshur County Family Resource Network, acting as Board Chair, Tri-County Child Exchange and Visitation Center appeared before the commission requesting \$7,500.00 for the 13/14 Fiscal Year donation. This is an increase of \$500.00 from the prior year donation. Upon motion of Agnes G. Queen, second by Thomas V. Fealy, vote unanimous to approve the request of \$7,500.00 for the Tri-County Child Exchange and Visitation Center.

IN RE: BOARD AND COMMITTEE REPORTS

Agnes G. Queen, Cindy Whetsell, Thomas V. Fealy, and Patrick D. Boyle attended West Virginia Association of Counties training in Charleston March 10, 11 and 12th. Cost of Regional Jail to counties was one of the topics discussed. Private discussion with the Gilmer County Commissioners revealed that the Gilmer County Commission could not start their 911 dispatch center this year. Another topic was the Oil & Gas industry and how it would be strong for the next 10 years. The governor's education reform was also discussed.




Budget Resolution






