Although a busy week for the commission with the move to the annex, there were no board or committee meetings. Commissioner Thomas Fealy reported attending the Jubilee and Jane Lew Fair. He noted that there was a very good turnout. Commissioner Fealy was a judge for the pie contest.

IN RE: ANNEX UPDATE

Lucinda Whetsell, County Administrator updated commission on annex move. All offices have moved into the annex. Offices are asked to wait six weeks before requesting changes. Changes must be submitted in writing with a cost estimate attached. Commission requested that thanks be extended to maintenance, Brad Tinney and all others for help with the move.

IN RE: ABLES PROPERTY (HOMWOOD HILL ROAD)

Michael Smith, Prosecuting Attorney at the request of the Lewis County Commission and on behalf of the Lewis County Safe Sites and Structures Board reported he had reached a tentative agreement with the Ables family on resolution of the problem of tearing down the half-burnt structure at Homewood Hill Road. Mr. Smith said if the commission would forgive the \$4000.00 debt for non-compliance with the order to demolish the building and the Ables family would then deed the property to the Lewis County Commission for a sum of \$500.00. The Lewis County Commission could then sell the property with the stipulation of the half burnt structure being removed within 90 days. Commissioner Patrick D. Boyle expressed concern in regard to the county purchasing any property and would prefer that Mr. Smith speak to the family regarding the sale of said property. After further discussion and upon motion of Agnes G. Queen, second by Thomas V. Fealy, vote unanimous, requested Mr. Smith act as mediator with the family for the sale of said property with the stipulation for cleanup of the building site within 90 days.

Whereas: Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week,



WHEREAS: the Lewis County Commission must designate an official representative to act in connection with the grant award and execute all necessary program documents,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:


