

Commissioners Thomas Fealy, Patrick D. Boyle, and Agnes G. Queen attended the watershed dam inspections.

Commissioner Thomas V. Fealy attended the Lewis County Ambulance Authority Board meeting. They are buying a 2010 ambulance to replace the one that was wrecked. Cost is \$95,000.00. They have enough money to pay cash for the vehicle.

Commissioner Agnes G. Queen and County Administrator Cindy Whetsell attended the hydroelectric meeting at the resort. The Army Corp of Engineers also attended the meeting and reported they are gathering information before they take a stand on the plant. There had been a hydroelectric plant there before and had been shut down due to killing fish. This is a small project at \$350,000.00 investment. Annual revenue from the plant would be about \$90,000.00.

Commissioners Queen, Fealy, and Boyle attended laying of the levy in the county clerk's office on Tuesday, April 15, 2014.

Commissioner Queen and County Administrator Lucinda Whetsell attended a meeting with the WV State Auditor's office on the pay raise for elected officials. The State Auditor is trying to determine the best method for determining whether a county is financially able to pay the raise.



4. Agnes G. Queen, President, or Lucinda A. Whetsell, Administrator is designated as the authorized official to act in connection with this grant closure.


