The Lewis County Commission sat as a Board of Canvass to canvass the votes cast for the Primary Election, May 13, 2014.


During the canvass fifteen (15) Provisional votes were found, and upon motion of Patrick D. Boyle, second by Agnes G. Queen, motion passing, eight (8) of the Provisional votes were counted, and seven(7) provisional votes not being counted.

Before the canvass started, one (1) absentee ballots was received and one (1) was counted.

Upon motion of Patrick D. Boyle, second by Agnes G. Queen, motion passing, that in the event of a recount requested by any candidate, the bond would be set at Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars.

The canvass was completed Monday, May 19th, 2014, at 11:45 o'clock, but results can not be certified until the last county completes their canvass. Upon notification of the Secretary of State's Office the Commission will meet to certify the results.
