1. **Upshur County Agenda** – A copy of the Upshur County Commission agenda for May 15, 2014 was filed. No comments.
2. **Sheriff's Monthly Settlement** – The Sheriff's monthly settlement for April (account reconciliation) was filed. No comments.
3. **Lewis-Gilmer Emergency 911 Advisory Board Meeting** – The minutes of the Lewis-Gilmer Emergency 911 Advisory Board Meeting for April 14, 2014 was filed.
4. **Lewis-Gilmer Emergency 911 Addressing Report** – the Lewis-Gilmer Emergency 911 Addressing report for the month of April, 2014 including: telephone inquiries, walk-ins, addresses issued, mileage driven and proof of address request was filed.
5. **Lewis-Gilmer Emergency 911 Call Totals** – The emergency 911 calls for the month of April including: number of calls by agency, distribution of calls and call comparisons was filed.
6. **Lewis County Family Resource Network Meeting** – A copy of the Family Resource Network minutes and Director's Report for the April 7, 2014 meeting was filed.
7. **West Virginia Regional Jail and Correctional Facility** – The West Virginia Regional Jail and Correctional Facility invoice for April, 2014 (inmate day 1687 x \$48.25 = \$81,397.75) was received. President Agnes Queen responded that this was the largest invoice to date. President Queen commented that there was a drug round up in April. The invoice would be even larger if Community Correction and Home Confinement programs did not pick up some of the inmates. 205 are on Community Corrections and Home Confinement, which would increase the regional jail bill by \$9,891.25 per day if they were in jail versus Community Corrections and Home Confinement.
8. **Shenandoah Cable Television (SHENTEL) Lineup Change** – Notification was received that SHENTEL is changing its cable television lineup. FX is moving.
