



1. **Upshur County Agenda** – A copy of the Upshur County Commission agenda for June 12, 2014 was filed. No comments.
2. **Lewis Gilmer E911 Advisory Board Meeting Minutes** – Lewis Gilmer E911 Advisory Board Minutes of May 12, 2014 meeting was filed. No comments.
3. **Lewis Gilmer E911 Monthly Addressing Report** – Lewis Gilmer E911 Addressing for April, 2014 including: telephone inquiries, walk-ins, addresses issued, mileage driven and addresses requested was filed. No comments.
4. **West Virginia State Auditor's Office Response Regarding Consideration of Increased Salary for County Officials Form** – Notice was received that the West Virginia State Auditor's Office has completed an analysis of the financial condition of Lewis County and certifies there are sufficient funds to support the payment of the salary increase to elected officials in Lewis County. Cindy Whetsell, County Administrator informed the commission that 27% of the counties did not qualify for the salary increase.
5. **West Virginia Regional Jail and Correctional Facility Authority Invoice for May, 2014** – The invoice was received for the WV Regional Jail and Correctional Facility Authority for May, 2014 in the amount of \$92,881.25 (Inmate days 1925 X \$48.25). Cindy Whetsell, County Administrator commented that the commission needed to investigate the possibility that court scheduling could be a contributing factor to high regional jail bills. Maybe the circuit court should have two judges not one. The sheriff commented that the drug courts could increase the regional jail bill. He had talked with other counties with drug court and it has increased their bills. Most of the offenders are drug offenses.
6. **Lewis County Monthly Animal Control Report** – Animal Control Report for May, 2014, includes number of complaints, animals picked up, bounty money, mileage from beginning of the month to the end of the month was filed. Commissioner Thomas Fealy questioned why Mr. Snyder did not pick up cats. County Administrator Cindy Whetsell responded that cats were not required to be penned, and that picking them up could cause a liability to the county.
