WHEREAS: the Lewis County Commission must designate an official representative to act in connection with the change of scope and execute all necessary program documents,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Michael Herron, Executive Director, EDA, reported the following:

6. Attending the EDA National Conference in Tennessee. (Grant requirement)

IN RE: WV ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES DUES

The Lewis County fiscal year 2015 invoice for dues to the West Virginia Association of Counties is \$5,000.00. With an ongoing feud between the directors of the WV Association of Counties and the County Commissioners' Association, the commission wanted to discuss with the elected officials the advisability of continuing their membership with the WV Association of Counties. Sheriff Adam Gissy could not be present but he sent his vote to remain a member of the WV Association of Counties. Assessor T. Chad Kelley recommended staying in also. He informed the commission that he would be serving as president of the Assessors' Association in 2016 and he would be utilizing the WV Association of Counties. Circuit Clerk John Hinzman recognized the personality conflict between the directors and commented that they needed to reconcile their differences. He voted to stay in. County Clerk Mary Lou Myers voted to stay in, she said that it was the only way all of the associations view points were made known to each other. Prosecuting Attorney Lea Ann Hawkins declined to vote as she did not have enough information to make an informed decision. Commissioner Patrick Boyle was against dropping out, he felt the problem was a power struggle between directors. Commissioner Agnes Queen voted to stay in for the knowledge. Commissioner Thomas Fealy voted to stay in. The commissioners directed Cindy Whetsell to send a letter to the directors and voice their disapproval of the feud and encourage them to work together. Commission agreed that if they can't get along they need to be replaced. On motion of Patrick D. Boyle, second by Thomas V. Fealy, vote unanimous to pay the dues.


