1. **Upshur County Agenda** – A copy of the Upshur County Commission agendas for August 7, 2014 was filed. Community Correction Grant was received for approval and signature.
2. **National Association of Counties (NACo)** – The commission received notice that the National Association of Counties member briefs senate staff on county use of behavioral health information technology to improve health outcomes. No comments.
3. **Lewis County Notice of Auction** – The state auditor’s office sent notification of the Delinquent and nonentered lands list of properties that will be offered for sale on August 27, 2014. It was noted there were seven pages of land listed, most of it being coal properties.
4. **West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources Office of the Chief Medical Examiner** – Notice was received that Keith Queen will no longer serve as County Medical Examiner in Lewis and Upshur Counties. Commissioner Boyle expressed concern that Lewis County would not have a medical examiner. County Administrator Cindy Whetsell will check with the state for clarification.
5. **West Virginia Department of Transportation**–The West Virginia Department of Transportation “Statewide Transportation Improvement Programs (STIP) sent notification of the updated list of projects. There were no Lewis County road projects.
6. **Lewis County Hazardous Material Response Team** – The minutes of the last meeting of the Lewis County Hazardous Material Response Team was received. Commissioners noted the team voted to dissolve. Lewis County will still be covered by the regional response team. Commission directed Ms. Whetsell to send letters to the team and Mr. Rowan on what the next step should be so the dispensation of the existing equipment and supplies can be dispensed in a timely manner.




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
