IN RE: MINUTES, INVITATIONS, NOTIFICATIONS, CORRESPONDENCE

1. **Upshur County Agenda** – A copy of the Upshur County Commission agendas for August 14, 2014 was filed. President Agnes Queen commented that 3 (three) employees resigned from the Tri County Visitation Center.
2. **Lewis Gilmer Emergency 911 Advisory Board Meeting Minutes** – The minutes of the July 14, 2014 Lewis Gilmer Emergency 911 Advisory Board meeting was filed. No comments.
3. **Region VII Planning and Development Council Meeting Minutes and Agenda** – the minutes of the April 22, 2014 meeting including Fiscal Year 2013-14 budget summary for quarter ending March 31, 2014 was filed. President Agnes G. Queen noted that there was an opening on the board for the industry section (i.e. supervisor or business owner). President Queen also noted that Todd Anderson from Senator Manchin’s office was leaving and would be replaced with Jessica Cell.
4. **Fiscal year 2014 Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) Notice** – An invitation to submit an application for the 2014 Land and Water Conservation Grant Fund was received.
5. **Lewis County Safe Structures and Sites Enforcement Agency Meeting Minutes** – The minutes of August 4, 2014 meeting was filed. President Queen reported that three members would need to be replaced or moved to another section. Mary Hogan, Kenny Reed and Mr. Hersman would need to be replaced or moved. Mary Hogan was not going to renew her surveyors license, Kenny Reed had a new job and was unable to attend meetings, and Mr. Hersman was resigning. Ms. Hogan could be moved to the “citizens member at large”. Commissioner Boyles suggested contacting Mr. Gary Riley, retired surveyor, to see if he was interested in serving on the board.
6. **WV Division of Highways Statewide Transportation Improvement Projects** – The Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Projects for 2015-2020 information has been made available for public comment for view or download at

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www.transportation.wv.gov. Comment deadline is September 9, 2014. County Administrator Cindy Whetsell commented this was the state's five year plan.

10. **Lewis County Family Resource network Meeting Minutes** – The meeting minutes of June 2, 2014 and Director's Report for June and July, 2014 was received. No comments.
11. **Lewis-Gilmer Emergency 911 Monthly Report** – The Lewis-Gilmer Emergency 911 Report for July, 2014 including: number of calls, department activities, disposition of call was received. President Queen noted the sheriff's departmental calls had increased.
