

General Election, November 4th, 2014.


During the canvass forty-one (41) Provisional votes were found, and upon motion of Thomas V.

of a recount requested by any candidate, the bond would be set at Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars.

The canvass was completed Monday, November 10th, 2014, at 1:00 o'clock. Results will be
certified on Friday, November 14th, 2014, at 9:00 o'clock.
