2. **Lewis County Animal Control Monthly Report** – A copy of October, 2014 Lewis County Animal Control Report including number of complaints, animals picked up, bounty collected, and vehicle mileage was filed. No comments.

Christina Flanigan, Prosecuting Attorney appeared before the commission and requested approval to hire Judge Kurt Hall as interim assistant prosecuting attorney at \$80,000.00 (Eighty Thousand) per year. Ms. Flanigan cited his many years of service as assistant prosecuting attorney in Harrison County and Judge in the 26th Circuit as reason for the increased salary. Commission directed Ms. Flanigan to advertise the position as soon as possible to comply with applicable laws. On motion of Thomas V. Fealy, second by Patrick D. Boyle, motion passing to approve the hiring of Judge Kurt Hall as interim prosecuting attorney on December 1, 2014 at \$80,000.00 per year. Commission also stressed that the higher wage was due to his experience and if someone of lessor experience was hired that the wage would be comparable to their experience.




