

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**IN RE: MINUTES, INVITATIONS, NOTIFICATIONS, CORRESPONDENCE**

1. **Upshur County Commission Agenda** – The Upshur County Agenda for Thursday, January 22, 2015 was received.
2. **West Virginia Public Service Commission Emergency 911 Wireless Subscriber Distribution** – West Virginia Public Service Commission has disbursed \$106,244.11 to Lewis County for Emergency Wireless Subscriber Fees for the months of October, November, and December, 2014.
3. **West Virginia Governor Earl Ray Tomblin Presents 14 Communities with Small Cities Block Grants** – West Virginia Governor Earl Ray Tomblin presented 14 West Virginia communities with Small Cities Block Grants. Lewis County was a recipient of \$250,000.00 for the first phase of the \$3.6 million North West Water Project. The full project will be funded over a series of cycles and is assured. President Queen reported that 150 homes will receive water from this project.
4. **Lewis County Animal Control Monthly Report** – The Lewis County Animal Control report for December, 2014 including: number of complaints, number of animals picked up, number of animals dropped off, number of animals adopted and number of animals euthanized.
5. **Lewis County Animal Control Facility Monthly Report** – The Lewis County Animal Control Facility report for December, 2014 including Lewis and Upshur Counties containing: number of animals brought by entity, number of animals dropped off, number of animals adopted, number of animals returned to owners and number of animals euthanized. Report for cats and dogs included.
6. **Lewis County Animal Control Annual Report** – The Lewis County Animal Control report for calendar year 2014 including: number of animals complaints, number of animals picked up, number of animals dropped off, number of animals adopted and number of animals euthanized.
7. **Sheriff's Amended Monthly Settlement** – The Sheriff's Amended Monthly Settlement (reconciliation of accounts) for December, 2014 was received. Concealed Weapons Fund total was the only amendment.
8. **Lewis Upshur Local Emergency Planning Committee Meeting Minutes** – The meeting minutes for the December 17, 2014 Lewis Upshur Local Emergency Planning Committee was filed. The committee made changes to the form for emergency shut ins.

**IN RE: APPROVAL OF \$6,500.00 FOR LEWIS COUNTY SENIOR CENTER ROOF**

Gary Morris, President of the Lewis County Senior Center Board of Directors appeared before the commission to request funding for the roof repair at the center. Total project cost is \$15,500.00, grant funds for \$9,000.00 have been approved. Mr. Morris requested the commission's help on the balance of \$6,500.00. The Lewis County Senior Center building and land is owned by the Lewis County Commission and leased to the Lewis County Senior Center. This roof replacement will replace the flat part of the building roof over the kitchen. On motion of Patrick D. Boyle, second by Agnes G. Queen, motion passing to approve the \$6,500.00 for roof repair. Funds will be taken from the 001-424-215.1 account.

9. **Monitoring and Emergency Action Plans for the Polk Creek Watershed Dams** – The West Virginia Soil Conservation Agency Watershed Office has prepared and approved monitoring plans for the Polk Creek Watershed Dams, Sites 1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 13. These plans are for use by the county if a crisis or emergency situation pertaining to the structure should occur. A copy is kept in the Lewis County Commission office and the Lewis County Office of Emergency Management and is available for viewing upon request.
10. **Fiscal Year 2015 Justice Assistance Grant Funding Available** – Notification that the West Virginia Division Justice and Community Services will be accepting applications for the 2015 Justice Assistance Grant Funding. This is used for the Prevention Resource Office position and requires a 25% financial match by the applicant. Sgt. Cayton and County Administrator Cindy Whetsell are working on the grant. It is due March 27, 2015.
11. **Cequel III Cable Franchise Fee Payment** – Franchise fee payment from Cequel III Cable, LLC dba Suddenlink in the amount of \$1,364.36 for October, November, and December, 2014 was received.


