

**ORDERS - - - BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, LEWIS COUNTY
REGULAR
SESSION: TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 17, 2015**

Commission sat pursuant to adjournment of Friday, February 13, 2015.

PRESENT: Honorable Agnes G. Queen, President, Thomas V. Fealy and Patrick D. Boyle, Commissioners.

The foregoing proceedings of this Commission were approved and signed by the President.

IN RE: MINUTES, INVITATIONS, NOTIFICATIONS, CORRESPONDENCE

1. **Upshur County Commission Agenda** – The Upshur County Agenda for Thursday, January 29, February 5, and February 12, 2015 was received. Commission noted the LEPC meeting was cancelled.
2. **WV Division of Culture and History** – The Lewis County Circuit Clerk's office received a grant from the WV Division of Culture and History in the amount of \$10,000.00 for the fiscal year July 1, 2015 thru June 30, 2016. The grant will be used for personnel costs to scan and index criminal case files using the county's record management program. The Governor will provide official notification to all grant recipients. A 10% cash match will apply to this grant.
3. **West Virginia University Extension Service** – The agenda for WVU Extension Service meeting for Thursday, February 19, 2015 at 7 pm was received. President Agnes G. Queen will be in attendance.
4. **Region VII Planning and Development Council**– The minutes of the quarterly meeting on October 27, 2014 and the Region VII Planning and Development Council agenda for January 27, 2015 and financial reports were received.
5. **West Virginia Development Office**– The Fiscal year 2015 CDBG-Small Cities Block Grant Application and Guidelines was received.
6. **State of West Virginia Department of Revenue State Tax Department** – Copies of the Administrative Notices for use in any mineral or industrial property appraisal/assessment hearing that occur during the Board of Equalization and Review.
7. **West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection** – An announcement was received related to changes in reporting water use – Effective January 1, 2015 the reporting threshold will be 300,000 gallons from service or groundwater sources in a 30 day period.
8. **Weston Police Department** – The Weston Police Department sent notice that due to budget constraints, they would not be replacing two officers. They will be eliminating the midnight shift three days a week and only covering till 2:30 AM the rest of the week. Chief of Police Randall Posey requests county coverage during that time. This is a temporary situation. Bill Rowan, 911 Director noted that the county officers cannot enforce city ordinances. It was noted that they are hoping to hire two officers at the next City Council meeting.
9. **Citizens Corp Council** – Bill Rowan, Director, Lewis County OEM sent a letter to the commission detailing the meeting of the Lewis County Citizen's Corp Council on January 20, 2015. Mr. Rowan stated that due to the events in the past that he and the members at the meeting on January 20, 2015 recommend reorganizing a CERT team for Lewis County in the late spring. He requested a budget of \$500.00 and the current \$875 that the CERT team has received via donations for the 2015-16 fiscal year budget.

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- 10. Levy Estimate (Budget) 2015-2016** – The county commission received the information on the 2015-2016 Levy Estimate from the West Virginia State Auditor’s office. In accordance with WV Code §11-8-10, as amended, each county commission is required to submit an estimate of revenues and expenditures to the State Auditor for approval by March 28, 2016. The Lewis County Commission will lay (set) the levy for 2015-2016 the third Tuesday of April, 2015.
- 11. Lewis Gilmer Emergency 911 Advisory Report** – The minutes of the Lewis Gilmer Emergency 911 Advisory Board meeting of January 12, 2015 was received. The meetings are back on regular schedule and will meet in Lewis County next.
- 12. Lewis Gilmer Emergency 911 Addressing Report** – The Lewis Gilmer E911 Addressing Report was received detailing number of telephone calls, walk ins, addresses issued/reissued, mileage driven and proof of address requests.
- 13. Shenandoah Cable Television, LLC (dba) Shentel** – Notification of cable television quarterly franchise fee payment for October, November and December 2014 was received. Lewis County received \$9,629.61.
- 14. West Virginia Regional Jail and Correctional Facility** – The WV Regional Jail and Correctional Facility invoice for January, 2015 was received. Inmate days 1,364 X \$48.25 = \$65,813.00. President Agnes G. Queen noted this was the lowest bill since February 2014 (\$56,597.25).

IN RE: VOCA 14/15 GRANT APPLICATION

Marcia Boyles, Victims of Crime presented the VOCA 15/16 grant application for signature. The grant amount requested is \$35,865.00 with the county contributing \$8,966.00 for match. The grant was approved on motion of Thomas V. Fealy, second by Patrick D. Boyle, vote unanimous to approve signature on the grant application.

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**IN RE: APPROVAL OF THE LEWIS COUNTY AUDIT
ADJUSTMENTS AND RESPONSE TO AUDIT FINDINGS**

The West Virginia State Auditor's Office completed the fiscal year 2014 audit of Lewis County. The auditor's office requests the commission to approve audit adjustment to accurately reflect the account status as shown on the financial statement. This is not an error or finding but simply relocation of accounts to meet the GASB standards that were mislabeled by the external agency that prepares the county financial statement. This is standard and done yearly. In addition the following audit findings were reported and a response is required:

1. Separate cash drawers for employees in County and Circuit Clerks' offices
2. Segregation of duties
3. Agreement to digitize record – County Clerk
4. Other post employment benefit liability reporting.

Response from the commission as follows:

1. Due to the inadequate space in these offices, there is not room to store, operate or maintain individual cash drawers for each employee. Alternative space solutions are being explored. The County Clerk is currently working with a vendor to obtain individual cash drawers that are compact and will be feasible for the lack of space.
2. Due to limited staff, Lewis County is unable to have complete segregation of duties. The Commission has established controls to provide monitoring and developed procedures to have reviews done by different offices.
3. The Lewis County Clerk executed an agreement with Chesapeake Energy for the purpose of digitizing documents recorded in the Clerk's Office. Per this agreement, both Chesapeake and the County received copies of the records. At the time the agreement was executed, the County Clerk was unaware this was a violation of Code. She contacted numerous other counties in the state of West Virginia and identified that they had signed similar contracts. Since learning from the WV State Auditor this is a violation, the Clerk will not enter into any agreement, written or verbal, that would provide shared record custody or usurp the statutory fees for document duplication.
4. The Lewis County commission subsidizes retiree health care insurance costs and is thus required by GASB Statement 45 to provide an actuarial for this liability. The county contract with Benefit Assistance Corporation in September, 2014 to have this actuarial done but it was not complete by the time the audit was performed. Their completed report is anticipated within 30 days and the county will immediately have the FY 2015 report scheduled to be performed.

On motion of Patrick D. Boyle, second by Thomas V. Fealy, vote unanimous to approve the audit adjustments and to approve the President signing the letter of response to the WV State Auditor.

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IN RE: REQUEST FOR DONATION TO THE LEWIS COUNTY FAIR

Alli Clark, Secretary for the Lewis County Fair appeared before the commission to request \$2,500.00. After discussion it was determined that the donation for this year had already been received. Commission will take the matter up after July 1, 2015, in the new fiscal year.

After checking bids to assure the correctness, on motion of Patrick D. Boyle, second by Thomas V. Fealy, vote unanimous to approve the low bid of \$67,250.00 from Richards Heating & A/C, LLC.
