



WHEREAS, approximately 3 million children are reported abused and neglected in this country each year; and


WHEREAS, the effects of child abuse are felt by whole communities and need to be addressed by the entire community; and


WHEREAS, effective child abuse programs succeed because of partnerships created among social service agencies, schools, religious and civic organizations law enforcement agencies, and the business community; and






