Cost to the average citizen with a \$100,000.00 home and one \$25,000.00 vehicle is less than \$30.00. The levy will raise approximately \$3,000,000.00 in the five years it will be in effect. Each of the six fire departments will receive approximately \$100,000.00 per year. The money will go towards operating costs and the costs to meet unfunded mandates from the legislature. If passed the fire fee will be discontinued. The fire departments are not able to meet the costs of upkeep of equipment to keep their ratings. Every engine must be replaced every twenty years. If they lose their rating or have to close down, the citizens will see higher costs of insurance, if they are able to get insurance at all. Commission pointed out that the city of Weston already has a municipal fee, a portion of which funds the city fire department. The Lewis County Fire Board will need to meet with the city council to discuss the possibility of decreasing / eliminating duplicate charges to the city residents. On motion of Thomas V. Fealy, second by Patrick D. Boyle, vote unanimous to table the decision until the fire board meets with the city of Weston.


