PRESENT: Agnes Queen, President; Patrick Boyle, Commissioner; Thomas Fealy, Commissioner; Cindy Whetsell, County Administrator; Cindy Rowan, County Clerk; Debra Hull, Deputy County Clerk.

The Lewis County Commission conducted a work session on Monday, March 14, 2016 at 1:00 PM to begin preparation of the Fiscal Year 2017 County Budget. Revenues and Expenditure patterns for the past eight (8) years were reviewed. The 2017 Ad Valorem taxes are \$4,205,173.00. This is a decrease of \$264,227.00 from 2016. The majority of this decrease was in Class III Business Personal Property.

The Commission expressed strong sentiment that no unencumbered funds would be used for everyday operating expenditures. Future trends in tax reductions were discussed. It is anticipated the oil and gas industry decline will continue to cause a loss in revenue for the next few years.

Each individual revenue and expenditure account was reviewed and estimates were determined. These were recorded to provide a basis for the remainder of the budget work sessions.

Having some additional time the following budget requests were reviewed:

Cynthia Rowan, County Clerk

Ms. Rowan requested an increase of \$1,500 in the county clerk travel budget. In the election budget, increases were requested for the following line items: \$1,500.00 increase in travel; \$3,500 in equipment repairs and maintenance; 500 in legal publications; and \$4000 in equipment. The elections building rent line item was decreased by \$75. Ms. Rowan stated after reviewing the overall budget, she retracted the increased requests. She voluntarily agreed to return her budget to the prior year level and decreased some line items for the overall strength of the county financial plan.

County Commission

Budget increases for the county commission contractual service account were requested in the amount of \$4,000. For the courthouse line item changes were requested for: telephone increase \$4,000; building repair and maintenance decrease to \$50,000 (this line item contained unencumbered from the prior year); repair and maintenance equipment decreased to \$115,000 (this line item contained carry over from last year); repair and maintenance of automobiles decreased by \$825; dues and subscriptions decreased \$1,000; contacted services decreased \$6,840; supplies and materials decreased \$2,800; auto supplies decreased \$25,000; computer equipment decreased \$5,000. The Regional Jail account was decreased by \$77,989. After overall review the county commission amended their requests to the prior year and decreased several line items for the overall strength of the county financial plan.


The work session was adjourned at 5:30 PM.
