

**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Lewis County should become involved in supporting families in raising their children in a safe, nurturing environment; and



At their April 11<sup>th</sup> meeting, County Administrator Cindy Whetsell reported the Lewis County Board of Health requested the Commission to add them to the county's general liability insurance policy;

There were questions on the coverage and the item was tabled for more information,

The county administrator spoke with Chris Heater, GJ Garton Insurance, the county's agent. The policy will cover any general liability claims in the building (ex. slip and fall); excluding professional liability and employment practices. This is the same coverage the county provides for all buildings but was previously covered under separate policy by the Board of Health. The addition of this coverage under the county's policy will be at no additional cost to the county and will save the Board of Health approximately \$12,000.00 annually.


