WHEREAS, there are approximately 900,000 law enforcement officers serving in the communities across the United States, including the dedicated members of the Lewis County Sheriff's Department;


WHEREAS, nearly 60,000 assaults against law enforcement officers are reported each year, resulting in approximately 16,000 injuries;


WHEREAS, the names of these dedicated public servants are engraved on the walls of the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington, D.C.;


