**IN RE: ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY UPDATE**

Michael Herron, Executive Director, Lewis County Economic Development Authority reported the following:

1. Companies are working more with site selectors and planners for possible expansion into new areas. Mr. Herron is working with Thrasher Engineering on a desktop site application that will provide information to these groups.
2. Working with a housing contractor planning to build in the county and scheduling on a fall housing summit.
3. The Roanoke School water project is 30% complete. Possible expansion to include all of Alum Fork/Laurel Lick in that project is expected to cost \$1,000,000.00. The Infrastructure and Jobs Development Council is being asked for the additional funds. Working on the North West water project.
4. Will be sending a new resolution for approval for \$400,000.00 additional grant funds for the access road to the new industrial park at no extra cost to the Economic Development Authority.
5. Attended a meeting with West Virginia American Water (WVAW) on capacity issues for the Weston Water treatment plant. WVAW is requesting approval of the Public Service Commission to expand service to Webster County from the Weston facility. WVAW was approved a 15% increase in basic service fees and they are requesting an additional surcharge.
6. Mr. Herron believes Lewis County is in a recession. He anticipates the service industry will be back when drilling resumes, possibly in 2018.

Commission came out of executive session at 12:35 PM per motion of Thomas V. Fealy, second by Patrick D. Boyle, vote unanimous.


