

The firemen wanted the public to know they will be answering all calls as they have available firemen. The fire departments have made an effort to assist their brothers in the south during the flooding.

President Agnes G. Queen and County Administrator Cindy Whetsell attended a meeting in Summersville with the FEMA officials. Legal requirements for reimbursements were discussed.




