
Whereas, in our country, more than three women are murdered by their husbands or boyfriends every day;


Whereas, children who grow up in violent homes are believed to be abused and neglected at a rate higher than the national average;

The Lewis County Commission conducted a work session on Monday, September 26, 2016 at 9:00 AM to discuss the current status of the Fiscal Year 2017 County Budget. The meeting was recessed at 9:45 AM and reconvened at 1:45 AM. All elected officials/department heads were informed that there would be no additional appropriations added to their budget. The Commission expressed all departments must strictly adhere to the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget Appropriations. Additionally, all were reminded that if leaving office, 50% of their department budget must be intact January 1, 2017.

The following concerns were expressed:

Sheriff Gissy expressed concerns that his vehicle maintenance and overtime line items may be short. He will do an inter-department revision to support these accounts. County Administrator Cindy Whetsell notified the commission that an inter-departmental budget revision will be required in the future for the Courthouse Materials and Supplies line item. Sheriff Gissy and Office of Emergency Management Director William Rowan advised that both departments have older vehicles that are beginning to incur costly repairs.

Each individual revenue and expenditure account was reviewed. All department are within limits. The County Commission expressed their appreciation for all of the diligence each official has given to managing their budget. Lewis County is fortunate to have such dedicated, team minded officials.

The work session was adjourned at 3:30 PM.
