**IN RE: APPROVAL OF SIGNING THE ENGAGEMENT LETTER FOR EXTERNAL
COUNSEL TO PURSUE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES**

At the December 12, 2016 meeting the following order was approved:

"The Lewis County Commission in collaboration with the Lewis County Board of Education advertised for external counsel to collect delinquent personal property taxes. Dr. Joseph Mace with the Lewis County Board of Education was agreeable to hire an attorney for collections. Expressions of interest were due to the Lewis County Commission office by noon, Friday, December 2, 2016. One was received from Stephen Sluss, Esquire. It is as follows:

Collections prior to filing a civil action – 10%

Filing and action but collection prior to trial – 15%

Taking the collection action to civil trial – 20%

Defending an appeal in the West Virginia Supreme Court – 25%

Plus any extraordinary costs not covered by state law

Defending an action in Federal Bankruptcy Court will be negotiated at an hourly rate on a case by case basis not to exceed 25% of the amount collected.

On motion of Thomas V. Fealy, second by Patrick D. Boyle, vote unanimous to approve the hiring of Stephen Sluss, Esquire. On motion of Patrick D. Boyle, second by Thomas V. Fealy, vote unanimous to limit the collections to anything over \$200,000.00 during five years of delinquency."
