



The Lewis County Commission convened a work session at 1:30 P.M. for the purpose of discussion of the preparation of the Lewis County Fiscal Year 2018 Budget with county elected officials and department heads.

Overall, all elected officials and department heads requested the same budget as approved for Fiscal Year 2017. Requests were:

- Sheriff Gissy \$1,300.60 to reimplement the Law Enforcement Retention Salary Plan and purchase of two new cruisers. The Sheriff requested \$250 annual increases for all full time non-law enforcement staff and \$.10 for all part time non-law enforcement staff.
- Circuit Clerk Burkhardt \$1,200.00 annual salary increase for staff. She stated they could use another employee but was not requesting at this time. An additional \$500 for supplies and materials due to increase caseload and a second judge.
- County Administrator Whetsell Increase Regional Jail line item by \$100,000.00. Increase Mental Health by \$200.00.
- OEM/911 Director William Rowan Increase county contribution to 911 by \$20,000.00

The Commission recessed the work session at 8:00 P.M. The next work session to prepare the County Fiscal Year 2018 Budget is scheduled for Wednesday, March 15, 2017, at 10:00 A.M.
